

Dear Customers,

Pursuant to the Proposition 218 mailer that was approved by our Board of Directors on March 17, 2016, water rate increases from the District's water supplier are treated as water rate "pass throughs". The District's water wholesaler is Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency (AVEK), and AVEK has scheduled their increase to be a 7.4%. Based on the District's management of water tiers for billing, the impact on the average residential bill will be less at 3.5%. Our residential customers can expect the overall increase to be from \$47.31 to 48.97. This increase will take effect on your bill dated February 7, 2017.
